Dr. Bush M. Moore, 68, who has practiced dentistry in **Corunna** and Owosso since 1905, died this morning at 9 o'clock at St. Lawrence Hospital, Lansing, after having been in failing health for nearly four years. Cancer was the cause of death.

The remains are to be brought here this evening, following an autopsy.

Dr. Moore was born September 1, 1882, south of **Corunna**, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Wallace Moore. He attended Corunna schools and **graduated** from the Corunna High School, and the University of Michigan in 1905.

He immediately set up practice in Corunna, remaining there until about 15 years ago when he moved to Owosso. His office was in the Connor Building.

Dr. Moore was an ardent sportsman, and not only loved to hunt and fish, but was a breeder of English setters. His kennels produced some of the finest dogs of this breed in the country.

He was a member of the Owosso City Club, the Town Club of Flint, and an honorary member of Zeta Psi Phi, dental fraternity. He was also a member of the Owosso lodge of Elks.

Surviving are his widow, the former Miss Florence Waldo, and two brothers, Clinton D. Moore of Durand, and Leon Moore of Chicago. Two other brothers preceded him in death.
