Irene Lyons, 75, of Bradenton, Fla., died in the Manatee Hospital there Tuesday afternoon. She had been ill for six months.

The funeral will be held at the Shelly Funeral Home in Eaton Rapids Saturday at 11 a.m., with the Rev. Paul Mergener officiating. Burial is to be in Hillcrest Memorial Gardens in Owosso.

Arrangements were made locally by Jennings-Lyons Chapel, where the body will rest from 7-9 p.m. Thursday before being moved to the Eaton Rapids funeral home to lie in state Friday.

Mrs. Lyons was born in Caledonia Township June 30, 1903 to George I. and Mayme (Moss) Aiken. She graduated from Corunna High School in 1921 and earned a bachelor of science degree from Eastern Michigan University.

Mrs. Lyons, before retiring from a Lansing school system in 1963, had taught in the Octagon, Bennington and Perry schools in this area, as well as Pleasant Grove school and Everett High School in Lansing.

She moved to Bradenton from Eaton Rapids in 1971 and was a member of the Bethel Baptist Church in Bradenton.

She was first married to Howard Lyons Nov. 25, 1926. She then married Leigh Lyons Nov. 16, 1976. He survives her, as do: One son, Richard of Menominee; one brother, N.B. Aiken of Bradenton, Fla.; three granddaughters, two grandsons, one great-grandson and one great-granddaughter.
